

SELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT FOR SUMMER ERASMUS+ PLACEMENTS -FACULTY OF MEDICINE-

To the attention of 4th and 5th year General Medicine students, 2nd year BFK and Radiology students, and 2nd and 3rd year Nursing students, First year master students

Dear students,

We inform you of the possibility to participate in the selection competition for **placement mobilities** (summer practice), within the Erasmus+ Programme, during the academic year 2021-2022.

Within the framework Erasmus+ Programme, the summer placement can take place in a **private**, **public**, **or university hospital**, **clinic or private practice**, **or any other medical organization from any EU country**, **Norway**, **Turkey**, **Iceland**, **Liechtenstein**, **Serbia**, **and North Macedonia**.

NEW! This year's programme allows for outgoing mobilities to any other country of the world. Therefore, you may also apply for a traineeship in an organization in a country outside the EU, bearing in mind that the places are limited. Erasmus + traineeships outside of Europe (outside of the ECTS system - transferable credits) cannot be recognized as a summer internship according to the curriculum. If you want to go to a country outside the EU, you must also take into account the legal requirements regarding the visa and the time required to obtain it. This traineeship will be mentioned in the Diploma supplement to your bachelor's degree.

The first condition is that the applicant obtains a <u>letter of acceptance/invitation</u> from the host institution, **signed and stamped** by the head of the department or of the ward/clinic or any other supervisor, before the application submission.

The second condition is that the student must have all previous exams passed when leaving for mobility.

The third condition is to possess a valid language certificate with a **minimum level of proficiency of B2**.

The duration of the Erasmus+ mobility for summer practice is of at least 2 months (60 days).

Applications for the 2022 Erasmus+ practice mobilities must be submitted via the online form available at the link:

All documents will be attached in a single PDF document, which will contain:

- \square CV- standard format published on the website
- ☑ Registration form (along with the letter of motivation) standard format published on the website
- \square Language Certificate <u>minimum B2</u> for the language of instruction issued by an authorized centre/institution; an English Certificate is accepted if the host institution agrees. If English is not the official language of the country of destination, then **the letter of acceptance/invitation must mention that the student is accepted with only English.**
 - In order to ensure better student-patient interaction, UMFIH strongly recommends students to have at least an intermediate level in the official language of the country of destination, even if the student is accepted only with English.
- ☑ <u>Letter of acceptance/invitation</u> from the host institution example published on the website
- ☑ GDPR agreement

The documents must be sent using the templates published on the website, on the Erasmus+ page.

Students can also find a letter of invitation template, but the template is NOT mandatory to be used.

The calendar for **submitting the applications** for the Erasmus+ practice is:

<u>April 1st – May 22nd 2022</u>

The selection procedure consists of evaluating the paper files submitted by the candidates. No proof documents are to be attached to these files <u>(only the aforementioned documents must be attached!)</u>. As the files are analyzed, if these are complete, candidates will be notified of their admission to the Erasmus+ Summer Practice.

<u>Note:</u> Students of other nationalities than Romanian have the right to apply for the Erasmus+ summer practice in institutions in their home country.

Native speakers of the language of instruction are not required to obtain a language certificate.

<u>ATTENTION!</u> A copy of the Baccalaureate diploma <u>CANNOT</u> replace a language certificate obtained at a national/international language testing center. The language certificate you submit must be within its duration of validity.



The number of spots available at the Faculty of Medicine:

- > 100 spots for General Medicine (BA) 4^{th} and 5^{th} year
- > 10 spots for Nursing (BA) -2^{nd} and 3^{rd} year
- > 10 spots for Radiology and Medical Imaging (BA) -2^{nd} year
- > 10 spots for Physio-Kinesiotherapy and Rehabilitation (BA) -2^{nd} year
- > 10 spots for Master degree students -1^{st} and 2^{nd} year

Specific conditions for taking part in the selection:

- ✓ Students must be enrolled in the specializations and study years above mentioned
- ✓ Students must have all previous exams passed before the start of their Erasmus+ traineeship
- ✓ Students must prove that they possess a <u>language certificate</u> for the language of instruction required by the host institution (**minimum B2 level**)
- ✓ Students must present the <u>letter of acceptance/invitation</u> for the summer practice, with a duration of <u>2 months (60 days)</u>, signed and stamped by the host institution (the exact period of the mobility will be mentioned in this letter)

In order to <u>equivalate</u> the Erasmus+ practice with the summer practice from the UMF, students in the 4th and 5th year at General Medicine specialization have to perform the practice <u>in a surgical or medical specialty</u>, accumulating <u>a minimum of 120 hours (5th year)/ 160 hours (4th year)</u> within the 2 months of mobility. For a better understanding on which are those specialties, we kindly ask you to check the information on summer practice and the UMF's summer practice agreement document, published on the website.

The Erasmus+ grant is between 650 - 750 euros/month.
